Klamath Dam Removal Project
Road Closure Extension
John Boyle Powerhouse Road and John Boyle Dam Road

When: December 31, 2024 – April 15, 2025

What: As authorized by the License Surrender Order issued by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) in November 2022, the Klamath River Renewal Corporation (KRRRC) performed necessary construction work related to the drawdown and deconstruction of the J.C. Boyle Dam and Powerhouse. Beginning on January 2, 2024, John Boyle Powerhouse Road and John Boyle Dam Road were temporarily closed for public safety due to an active construction zone. This closure is extended until at least April 15 while the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and KRRRC install protective measures to ensure public safety and restoration success.

Where: John Boyle Powerhouse Road and John Boyle Dam Road are both closed at their respective junctions on Highway 66.
